If you need to contact your child's class teacher about anything, please send them a message via Tapestry (YR) or Seesaw. Teachers check their seesaw messages regularly and at least once before the school day begins. This means that messages will go directly to the teacher and be picked up quickly. An email to the office may not be picked up until much later in the day.



We have several bugs in school at the minute, which are affecting children in all year groups and quite a few staff too. Most of them are of the stomach bug/cold/covid variety, with the children reporting feeling sick, having headaches and high temperatures. We are encouraging thorough and regular hand washing, with soap and water during the day, especially after visiting the toilet and before eating. We would appreciate it if you would reinforce this at home too please. Also, to minimise the spread of infection, please remember that your child needs to be kept at home for 48 hours after their last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea before they can return to school.

Book Swap! Each Friday your child will have a chance to bring in any of their own books and swap it with a book from our swap shop! They can keep the book, pass it along or bring it back to swap it again! KS2 children have made lots of swaps already and it would be lovely to see KS1 and YR children joining in too.
