IMPORTANT INFORMATION - School lunches

Mrs Ridsdale, our cook, is going to be off work for 2 weeks from Wednesday September 10th returning on Wednesday September 24th. This has a significant impact on our capacity to offer our usual school lunches during that time. It means that for those 2 weeks we are only able to offer a school meal to those children who are entitled to a free school meal. This means all children in CR, C1 and C2 can still have their school lunch provided. If your child is in C3, C4, C5 or C6 and entitled to a free school meal, please contact the school office and we will make arrangements with you, for your child. Unfortunately, for those 2 weeks, all other children will need to bring a packed lunch. Thank you for your understanding.
